Addressing knowledge gaps in individualized FcRn treatment for the management of generalized myasthenia gravis (gMG) care

Through this RFP, it is our intent to support IME/CME programs in the following areas of interest.

Areas of Interest

- Increase understanding and competence of mechanism of action, efficacy, safety, and place in therapy of the use of FcRn antagonists in patients with gMG
- Identify patients who are appropriate candidates for FcRn therapy and develop an individualized treatment plan in terms of dosing frequency, emerging route of administration while incorporating patient preference
- Increase competence and performance on optimal dosing and safety profile of FcRn antagonists in terms of infections, reduce treatment burden of traditional therapies, and improve patient's quality of life

Program Format Considerations

- Program to start after May 1st, 2025
- Enduring content for at least 12-months after launch of program
- Preference for round table or a variety of content formats as recommended by IME provider
